The Wallonie Cyclable (WaCy) action plan

4 components, 20 measures :

1. Ensuring Governance
2. Cycling and Parking
3. Providing Services
4. Communication



The Wallonie Cyclable action plan

Ensuring Governance :

- To ensure the implementation of the Cycling Strategy
- To implement a training plan
- To ensure the follow-up and progression of the regulations and planning of the cycling policy
- To ensure the monitoring of the cycling policy
- To ensure the networking of cycling stakeholders

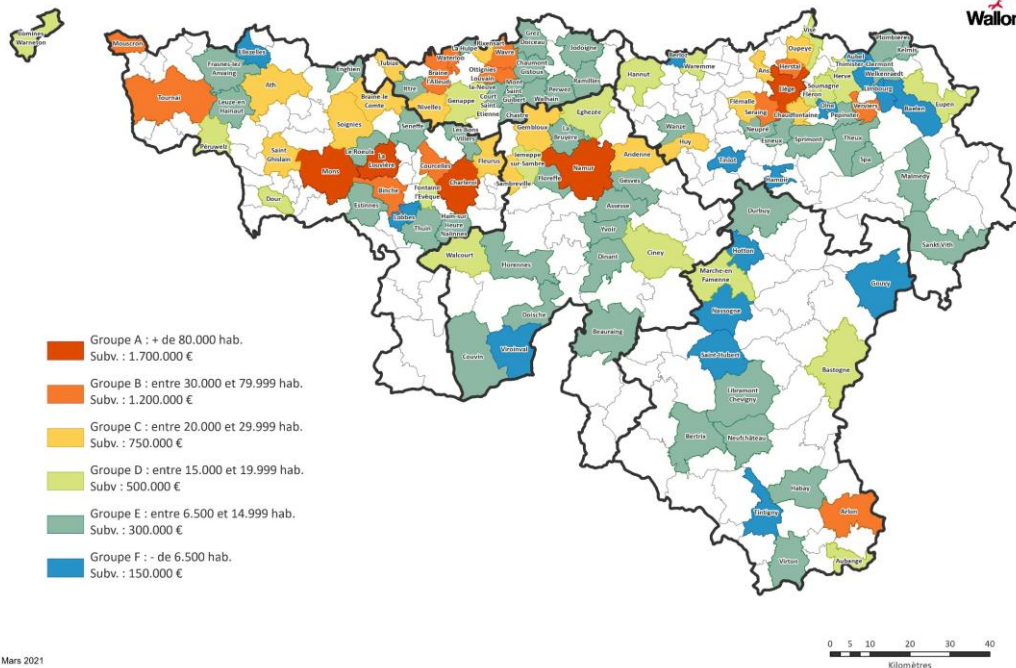


The Wallonie Cyclable action plan

- Providing quality bike parking
- Ensuring quality signage and road marking

Definition of a Cycling Corridor

Clearly identifiable, inclusive and continuous route that serves as a collector for daily trips by bicycle and similar devices and that optimally meets the needs of cyclability.



The Wallonie Cyclable action plan

Providing services :

- To have a sufficient supply of bicycle repair services
- To have a supply of bicycles to rent, lend and test
- To develop trainings to learn to ride a bike
- To have aid for purchase (bicycle, equipment)
- To develop the urban cyclo-logistics
- To prevent bicycle theft

The Wallonie Cyclable action plan

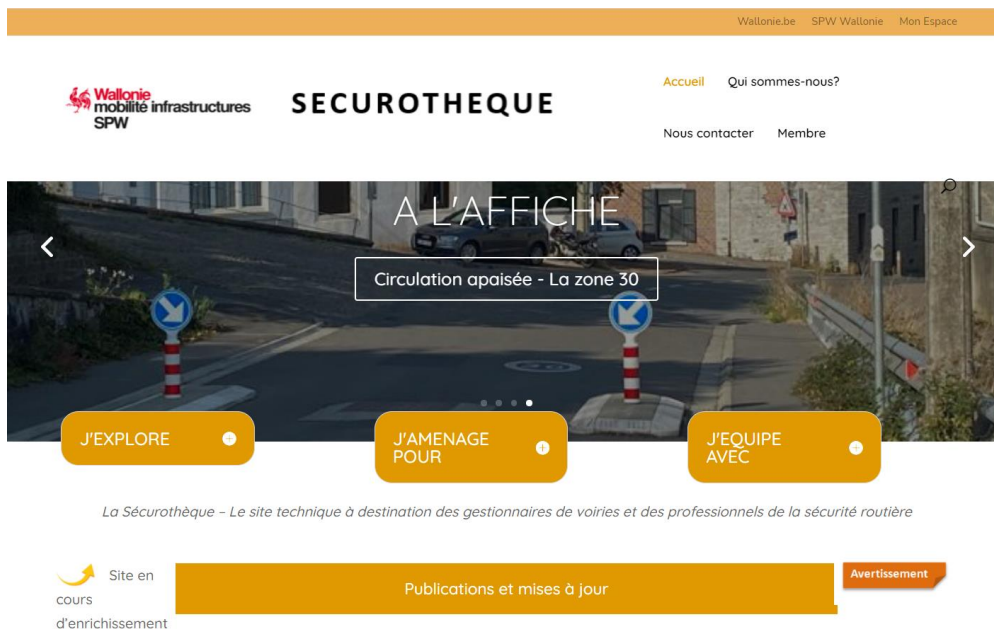
Communication :
